Can we have the second assembly on a different day?	I recognise that the assemblies aren't always working at the moment and we will be having Monday and Friday assemblies back. The Monday assembly will be held by a member of SLT, with Friday continuing to be the British Values-Focused Assembly with rewards.

One was because too many students were starting to walk around the corridors rather than go into form time. The second is that the door at the end is broken and we are trying to reduce its use until it can be replaced over the summer holidays. We will discuss this in SLT meetings and try and find a solution.
